

GSAC TRACK AND FIELD POLICIES

I. GSAC CHAMPIONSHIP

- A. The Conference Championship will not have event qualifying standards, and the number of entries per team for an event can be equal to the number of scoring places (currently 6).
- B. There will be a two-day conference meet.
- C. The championship meet will be held on the last weekend in April that has both a Friday and Saturday for the event. Start time will be determined by the host school.
- D. The Conference Commissioner will select a Meet Director to be paid by the conference. (1/9/2008)
- E. The site rotation is:
 - 2008 - hosted by Azusa Pacific
 - 2009 - hosted by Point Loma Nazarene
 - 2010 - hosted by Westmont
 - 2011 - hosted by Fresno Pacific
 - 2012 - hosted by Azusa Pacific
- F. The Coach of the Year award will be presented after the Conference Championship event.

II. AWARDS

- A. Conference banner to first place team.
- B. Individual certificates to GSAC Meet Championship Team.
- C. All-Conference Team receives medals for first, second and third place.
- D. Award to Coach of the Year. This will not necessarily go to the winning coach, but will be voted on by all GSAC coaches after the championship meet.

III. SPORTS CHAIR

The Sports Chair selection will be determined by a vote of the member coaches. The term shall be two years.
