



What am I doing to receive His Guidance

God's invitation for you to work with Him always leads you to a crisis of belief that requires **faith** and **action**.

Moses – Exodus 3:11; 4:1, 10

Key Question:
Will I trust him and step out in faith?

You must make major **adjustments** in your life to join God in what **He is doing.**

*Moses – Ex 4:19-20;
Hebrews 11:24-29*

Key Question:
Am I willing to set aside my agenda to join God in what is doing?

You come to know God by experience as you **obey** Him and He accomplishes His work through you.
